FIRST Team 662, Rocky Mountain Robotics Lettering Requirements 2022-2023

Mandatory Activities: Must have to qualify for a letter during the season

- Must have Fee (\$50) paid by October 12, 2022
- Students and parents must complete online RMR registration by October 12, 2022
- Students and parents must complete online FIRST Consent and Release (STIMS) before October 12, 2022
- Must attend the FRC Kickoff January 7, 2023
 - o Location to be determined
- Must earn 16 hours of Community Service/ Robotics Advancement
 - o Students are encouraged to attend robotic/science related events to promote the FIRST ideas and to promote RMR 662.
 - o Can be accomplished outside of robotics or as a part of team community service events -Community Service forms must be signed and dated by supervising adult.
 - o Examples of robotics advancement include: FLL Support, Volunteering at a regional competition, Sponsoring a Lego League Team, and Attending the Cool Science Fair at UCCS.
- Must attend and be productive at all scheduled build season department meetings.
 - o Students will be allowed one (1) excused absence (cleared by a Coach, CEO or VP) during this time
 - o Student leaders will schedule students a variety of hours each week.
 - o Student must be present and working on the robot or other team activity.
- Must attend one full regional competition (all days of regional)
 - o Students must attend all days of competition from opening ceremonies to closing ceremonies.
